## 2. King Solomon's advice

- o His downfall was going solo

<sup>29</sup> God gave Solomon very great wisdom and understanding, and knowledge as vast as the sands of the seashore. <sup>30</sup> In fact, his wisdom exceeded that of all the wise men of the East and the wise men of Egypt. <sup>31</sup> He was wiser than anyone else... His fame spread throughout all the surrounding nations. <sup>32</sup> He composed some 3,000 proverbs and wrote 1,005 songs. <sup>34</sup> And kings from every nation sent their ambassadors to listen to the wisdom of Solomon.
