1. The truth about complaining

- o Biblical command to not complain
- Complaining is <u>blaming</u> <u>God</u>

¹⁴ Do everything without complaining and arguing, ¹⁵ so that no one can criticize you. Live clean, innocent lives as children of God, shining like bright lights in a world full of crooked and perverse people. **Philippians 2:14-15** NLT

... He has heard all your complaints against him. What have we done? Yes, your complaints are against the LORD, not against us." **Exodus 16:8** NLT

2. What should we do?

- If you can change your circumstances,
 do something about it
- If you can't change your circumstances,
 change your perspective

¹⁷ But I will rejoice even if I lose my life, pouring it out like a liquid offering to God, just like your faithful service is an offering to God. And I want all of you to share that joy.

¹⁸ Yes, you should rejoice, and I will share your joy.

Philippians 2:17-18 NLT

3. How can we change?

- See the good that God is doing
- See that <u>Jesus</u> is at the <u>center</u> of the <u>story</u>

² Let all that I am praise the LORD; may I never forget the good things he does for me. ³ He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. ⁴ He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies. ⁵ He fills my life with good things. Psalm 103:2-5 NLT

¹² And I want you to know, my dear brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me here has helped to spread the Good News. ¹³ For everyone here, including the whole palace guard, knows that I am in chains because of Christ. Philippians 1:12-13 NLT
