1. How do Christians express our worship?

- Sometimes we bow or kneel in worship
- Sometimes we lift our hands in adoration
- Sometimes we dance in celebration
- Sometimes we worship with a <u>sacrifice</u> of praise
- We daily lay down our <u>lives</u> as an <u>act</u> of worship

Come, let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before the LORD our maker... Psalm 95:6 NLT

I will praise you as long as I live, lifting up my hands to you in prayer.

Psalm 63:4 NLT

Praise his name with dancing, accompanied by tambourine and harp. Psalm 149:3 NLT

Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name.

Hebrews 13:15 NLT

¹ And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.
