1. You may not be who you <u>want</u> to be, but because of Christ you're exactly who God needs you to be

<sup>26</sup> Remember, dear brothers and sisters, that few of you were wise in the world's eyes or powerful or wealthy when God called you. <sup>27</sup> Instead, God chose things the world considers foolish in order to shame those who think they are wise. And he chose things that are powerless to shame those who are powerful. <sup>28</sup> God chose things despised by the world, things counted as nothing at all, and used them to bring to nothing what the world considers important.

1 Corinthians 1:26-28 NLT

- 2. Faith in Christ makes <u>extraordinary heroes</u> out of <u>ordinary people</u>
- 3. How do we prepare to be God's hero?
  - Be available
  - Be obedient
