## 1. The prayer: Same attitude towards each other that Jesus had / unity

So that...

- We will be <u>united bringing God glory</u>
- The world will know Jesus is for real

<sup>5</sup> May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, <sup>6</sup> so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

<sup>7</sup> Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.

Romans 15:5-7 NIV

20 ... I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, 21 that all of them may be one... 23 so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

John 17:20-21, 23 NIV

## 2. Why we pray for unity...

- Because we can do more <u>united</u> than we can do separately
