Fearing people is a dangerous trap, but trusting the LORD<br/>the LORD means safety.Proverbs 29:25 NLT

- 1. Three problems that people pleasers battle
  - Obsessing about what others think
  - Being overly sensitive to <u>criticism</u>
  - Have a hard time saying "no"
- 2. Important facts about people pleasers
  - It's a form of idolatry / idol worship
  - The <u>approval of God</u> sets us free from the <u>disease to please</u>

<sup>42</sup> Many people did believe in him, however, including some of the Jewish leaders. But they wouldn't admit it for fear that the Pharisees would expel them from the synagogue. <sup>43</sup> For they loved human praise more than the praise of God. John 12:42-43 NLT

Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant. Galatians 1:10 NLT

  - Forgiven / sins washed away (Eph. 1:7)
  - More than a conqueror through Christ (Romans 8:37)
  - God's masterpiece (Eph. 2:10)
  - Christ's ambassador (2 Cor. 5:20)
  - Greatly loved by God (Romans 1:7)
