## 1. How to respond to critical people

- Sometimes, you don't respond
- Sometimes, you <u>respond</u> <u>carefully</u>
- Sometimes, you listen and make a change

## 2. What if you are the vampire?

- Don't let <u>compliments</u> go to your <u>head</u> and don't let <u>criticism</u> go to your <u>heart</u>
- Guard your heart

10 So why do you condemn another believer? Why do you look down on another believer? Remember, we will all stand before the judgment seat of God... 12 Yes, each of us will give a personal account to God. 13 So let's stop condemning each other. Romans 14: 10, 12-13 NLT

Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life. **Proverbs 4:23** NLT
