¹⁸ "Come now, let's settle this," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, I will make them as white as snow. Though they are red like crimson, I will make them as white as wool. **Isaiah 1:18** NLT

- 1. Struggling with the ghosts of our past sins
 - Try to <u>bury</u> and <u>forget</u> them
 - <u>Beat</u> <u>ourselves</u> up or <u>blame</u> others

My guilt overwhelms me - it is a burden too heavy to bear. **Psalm 38:4** NLT

2. We can't earn our forgiveness, it is a gift

¹² I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength to do his work. He considered me trustworthy and appointed me to serve him, ¹³ even though I used to blaspheme the name of Christ. In my insolence, I persecuted his people. But God had mercy on me because I did it in ignorance and unbelief. ¹⁴ Oh, how generous and gracious our Lord was! He filled me with the faith and love that come from Christ Jesus. ¹⁵ This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" - and I am the worst of them all. **1 Timothy 1:12-15** NLT

3. Mary had ghosts from her past

- Pregnant <u>before</u> she was married
- Mary wasn't the <u>sinner</u> at Christmas

²⁶ In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee, ²⁷ to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. ²⁸ Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you!" ²⁹ Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean. ³⁰ "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! ³¹ You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. ³² He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. ³³ And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!" ³⁴ Mary asked the angel, "But how can this happen? I am a virgin…" ³⁸ Mary responded, "I am the Lord's servant. May everything you have said about me come true." And then the angel left her. Luke 1:26-34,38 NLT

- 4. We fight the ghosts of our past with the <u>truth</u> of Jesus' <u>love</u> and <u>forgiveness</u>
 - God has already <u>forgiven</u> you, you just have to <u>believe</u> it and <u>receive</u> it
 - God wants to <u>turn it around</u> for good

Next Steps:

- I believe that Jesus lived and died to take away my sins. I receive God's forgiveness for all of my sins.
- □ Let go of the ghosts from my past and focus on God's amazing grace and forgiveness to me
- □ Trust in God that he will turn the hard things from my past into something good
